Academic Program & Marking System

Pike County High School offers its students a traditional 6 period day schedule, with students receiving ½ credit for each class at the end of each semester. There is a numeric weighted GPA scale used to calculate class ranking for students. This GPA is provided on official transcripts as well. Students entering high school during the 2021-2022 school year or after are required to have 23 units with one program of study that leads to a high school diploma in Georgia.

Honors/Advanced Placement/Dual Enrollment

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses are offered in English A=90-100 B=80-89 C=70-79 F=69 and below

Language, English Literature, Seminar, Research, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, World History, US History, American Government, Economics, Psychology, Biology, Environmental Science, Physics, Chemistry, and Music Theory. Honors courses are offered in most subject areas. Dual enrollment opportunities are available beginning in 10th grade. An extra quality point is added for all AP and Dual enrollment courses successfully completed.

Career and Technical Agricultural Education

Pike County High School offers technical preparation in a variety of career pathways. Our program of study options include: Allied Health & Medicine, and Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources. Students may also dual enroll at Southern Crescent Technical College.
