

Prom Info 2026

– Delta Flight Museum - 1220 Woolman Place, Hapeville, GA 30354

- April 18, 2026, from 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. at the Delta Flight Museum. Doors WILL NOT open until 7:00. Please do not arrive early thinking you will beat the crowd. They will not be ready for you.
- Prom tickets will be sold 8:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. starting on Monday January 12 – February 27 for \$75 per person and March 2 – April 3 for \$100 per person. Tickets will be sold on GoFan. The last day to buy tickets is **Friday April 3, 2026**.
- Guests of PCHS students that are **not** students at PCHS must submit a **Prom Date Application Form**. Prom Date Application forms will be available in Ms. Harrison's office. These forms will be reviewed by the administration and permission to attend granted or denied. Applications are due to Ms. Harrison no later than Friday, March 20, 2026.
- Prom is intended for seniors, juniors, and their guests. Only students classified as a Junior or Senior will be allowed to purchase tickets. Any student participating in any buying, selling or exchanging prom admission after the initial purchase, or any type of deception to enable another person to enter the Prom, will be subject to disciplinary action. This may include exclusion from the event. Prom Tickets are nonrefundable and **nontransferable from person to person**. When you purchase your ticket(s), your name and your guest's names are put on the entrance list. You **can not** sell or give your ticket to anyone else. Their name will not be on the list at the door. Persons whose names are not on the list will be denied entry to prom. **Name changes can only be made by Ms. Harrison. (See her if you have issues.)**
- This is a formal event. **Blue jeans are NOT formal wear**. All body parts that should be covered at school, should be covered at prom. Sheer or see through material is not considered a covering. Please dress accordingly and always conduct yourself as young ladies and gentlemen, including while on the dance floor.
- All school rules regarding conduct and discipline will be in effect. Be sure that "guests" who are not PCHS students understand they will be expected to follow all school rules and policies. Conduct on the dance floor will be monitored.
- All students and their guest may be asked to show a photo ID upon arrival.
- There will be flashing lights, darkness and loud music inside the ballroom.
- **Wrist bands will be issued to everyone attending prom. These wrist bands must be worn for the duration of prom and shown to enter the ballroom at any time. Wrist bands are not to be removed while at prom.**
- Everyone will go through Delta's Security. This means metal detectors & bags/jackets/etc. will be x-rayed. Per Deltas policy.
- Students who do not have a ticket to prom should not be on Museum property. There is no waiting area.
- Parking at the Museum is complementary.
- Heavy Hors d'oeuvres and beverages are served at Prom for the enjoyment of students and their guests.
- Students and guests are **not allowed** to leave the Prom and return.
- In the event of inclement weather, this event will go on as scheduled. There are no refunds for weather.
- **IF YOU ARE DENIED ENTRY TO PROM FOR ANY REASON. YOUR MONEY WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.**
